

**PARENTAL ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF MINOR'S  
COMPUTER/INTERNET USE  
CARTHAGE FREE LIBRARY**

It is the policy of the Carthage Free Library that parents, legal guardians, custodial caregivers are responsible to monitor information accessed by his or her child under the age of 18, including internet access. Some internet sites are not appropriate for minors. It is your responsibility to address internet safety and security and to urge the minor to never give out personal information or personal identification over the internet, nor arrange to meet anyone via an internet contact.

The Library will not assume parental authority. The Library is NOT able to monitor or control the content of information available on the internet and is not responsible for the networked information available. The Library DOES NOT filter internet sites. Only if it is brought to our attention that a person is viewing objectionable material will we be able to act. The Library is NOT responsible for any harm, damage, expenses or charges resulting from internet use.

Users agree to follow the policy of the Library set up for computer use and internet access. They agree to comply with all laws including copyright laws and hold the Library harmless from any and all claims, losses and damages resulting from internet activity. Anyone failing to comply will lose internet and computer privileges for a period of time.

All minors under the age of 18 must have this acknowledgment signed by their parent, guardian or custodial caregiver in order to be granted computer and internet access. Parent or guardian must hand in this form, in person, to the Library.
